- French Easel preferred or portable easel

Oils - Cadmium Yellow Light, Yellow Ochre, Raw Sienna, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson, Cerulean Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Viridian Green, Sap Green, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber. Ivory Black, Lg. Titanium White, Grumbacher Thalo Red Rose, Dioxazine Purple (optional color Grumbacher Red or Cadmium Red Medium)

Brushes \#2, \#4, \#6, \#8, \#10 Oil, Filberts, hog hair (Robert Simmons) \# 8, \#10 Oil Brights hog hair (Robert Simmons) Large Mop Brush Palette knife, one large \& 1 small. \#2 Flat Sable for detail (synthetic), (1/2" \& 1" Flat Sable synthetic) to soften edges. $2 "$ Flat soft wash brush cheap about a $\$ 1.00$ or less (Walmart)

Odorless Paint thinner (Sunnyside) ONLY I will bring extra cans for anyone who can't find it. Costs about 9.00 Qt. plus tax. Bring med. size jar with lid (preferably with screen on bottom for wiping/cleaning brushes) Note: I have found this thinner to be the most tolerable for painters, lowest odor, and no allergic reactions. Gamsol is acceptable also by Gamblin.

Dioxazine purple, Radiant violet, Transparent earth red, Transparent Orange, Indian Yellow, Portland gray Lt., Radiant Blue, Radiant Yellow, Fr. Ultramarine Blue, a 150 ml . tube of Titanium or Zinc White.

Blue/Black, Olive Green

## REMBRANDT ( 40 ml tubes)

Warm Grey, Cool Grey, Terre Verte, Cadmium Red Lt.

Primary Red, Primary Yellow

## Necessaries:

An easel or a pochade box with a tripod, a palette (paper, plastic or wood), Gamsol or other odorless mineral spirits, a can or jar with lid.

Umbrella to shade you \& your work, palette knife
Hog bristle brushes: \# 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 in either Bights or filberts, a \#4 round and a soft hair \# 16 synthetic.

Paper towels (please bring a bag to take all waste home), Nitrile glove (Walgreen's) used in performing a "rub-in" technique.
$9 " \times 112^{\prime}, 12^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ and or $18^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ stretched canvas or canvas panels Sketch book, kneaded eraser, 4B pencil

Winsor Newton tubes ( 5 ml or 14 m .) or equivalent ie.) Daniel Smith
Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Violet
Cadmium Yellow Light, Yellow Ochre, New Gamboges, Naples Yellow
Rose Madder or Permanent Rose (* a red with Quinacridone in it), Cadmium Red Light Olive Green, "Thalo" or Viridian Green, Davy's Gray, Burnt Sienna, Raw Umber

## Other Supplies:

\#6 and \#10 round brushes and a \#36 round or a 1" flat brush, a synthetic sponge
140 \# stretched W. C. Paper or 300\# paper or a W. C. Block
*(please soak and stretch 140 \# (or less) paper onto a gator board or homasote. Do NOT
TAPE IT DOWN). Suggested sizes to work on: 8 " x $10 ", 9 " \times 12 ", 12 " \times 20 "$
Sketchbook, kneaded eraser, a 4H pencil for value studies, a W.C. Easel or some type of surface to paint on, paper towels.
